Team London comes to Beormund

Team London Young Ambassadors is the Mayor's volunteering programme for primary and secondary schools across the capital. The programme inspires and supports young people to develop community projects on social issues they are passionate about.

The children at Beormund have been busy organising and participating in a range of projects to help improve their school community or local area. These included organising a sponsored penalty shoot-out where the money was donated to the local homeless shelter, Manna Society. In March, children were asked to donate money to take part in the Easter Egg Hunt. So far over £35 has been raised for the Manna Society.

Children also collected food donations from the public for the shelter.

Cushions and origami flowers were made for our local Elderly Care Home which the children visited and presented to them.

Money was raised for Oxfam by organising a sponsored splash, where the children got very wet! So far £18 has been raised.

Projects to improve our school environment have also been a huge success. Children have cleaned the school pond, litter picking, cleaning graffiti around the school and planted vegetables and plants in our garden.

Upcoming events include a sponsored mini marathon, round 2 of Splash, Loom band competition, Karaoke, health and fitness class run by the children and selling clothing items for The Salvation Army at our family fun day in July.

All the children have put in a lot of work and effort into all their projects and we are very proud of their achievements!
