Beormund Primary is a unique special needs setting supporting children with social, emotional and mental health needs. All children have an Education and Health Care Plan (EHCP) outlining their complex, personalised needs. Their thoughts, feelings and vulnerabilities are often communicated through disengaging behaviours with many having been excluded from a mainstream setting. Some children arrive having experienced trauma, unmet attachment needs, a significant number of ACEs, a plethora of medical diagnosis and a disassociation with the education system. Collectively as a team, we aim to help children to enhance their self-esteem, build relationships and trust in order to support them to challenge themselves academically, socially and emotionally, progress and find success.

The post involves the provision of contact, information, advice, challenge, guidance, support and encouragement. As a Home School Liaison Officer your day will be varied The role is diverse and unpredictable. No two days are ever the same here at Beormund.

We are in no doubt that family support and engagement has a positive impact on all aspects children's learning. We value the work we do with our parents and carers and this role is integral to keeping our children safe at school. You will be an active member of the schools safeguarding team as a DDSL.

The right candidate will be personable, diligent, organised and work well under pressure. You will be able to communicate effectively with a whole range of colleagues and professionals to work in the best interests of the child.
