School Expectations for curriculum coverage: There are 11 explicit opportunities for teachers to plan and deliver sessions (9 if swimming). The expectation is for teachers to deliver core subjects daily – at least 3-4 Maths and 3-4 English lessons per week.

Once a week all classes are expected to deliver: double science which incorporates STEM and science investigative skills, one explicit PSHE session, one Music session, one Art or DT. Teachers are expected to cover the ICT/Computing curriculum and online safety.

Enrichment Wednesdays (Cultural Capital & life skills) may involve visits to museums, galleries, theatres & parks – or visitors into the school. It may involve local trips/surrounding area or visits to the local library.

There are 5 House Days throughout the year – These will cover all aspects of the curriculum including Humanities - History/Geography and RE topics. All children receive Lego Therapy in line with their complex Speech Language & Communication Needs.

Class teachers to note on the timetable children who attend therapies and when. Teachers are asked to look to vary their timetabling, where possible, to ensure children do not regularly miss the same session.
